

THE “EARLY” PERIOD 1980-1989

The decade of the eighties brought a transition to Collins covers as they gradually moved from the standard, traditional left-side cachet to “entire” envelope cachet. This means that the stamp, postmark and cachet combined take up the entire face of the envelope. Collector feedback was outstanding and the excellent reputation of Collins continued to grow. As time goes on, the “Earlies” from this period in his cachetmaking will become harder to find and acquire. Any Collins collection will be more meaningful and significant if it includes FDCs from the “Early” period of the 1980s. Please remember that cancel and/or cachet varieties may exist on following covers. They are catalogued and illustrated in the *Collins First Day Covers - The First Twenty Years - 1978 -1997* book for precise cover variety identification..
